1	September 6-9, 2011	<i>Mark 13:31</i> "Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away."
2	September 12-16	<i>Exodus 20:2-12 (from the King James Version)</i> "I am the Lord thy God. Thou shalt have no other gods before Me. Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image. Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain. Remember the sabbath day to keep it holy. Honor thy father and thy mother."
3	September 19-23	<i>Exodus 20:13-17 (from the King James Version)</i> "Thou shalt not kill. Thou shalt not commit adultery. Thou shalt not steal. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor. Thou shalt not covet."
4	September 26-30	<i>Luke 16:10</i> "Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much, and whoever is dishonest with very little will also be dishonest with much."
5	October 3-7	<i>Jeremiah 29:11</i> " 'For I know the plans I have for you,' declares the Lord, 'plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.'"
6	October 11-14	<i>Psalms 119:11</i> "I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you."
7	October 17-21	<i>1 John 1:9</i> "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness."
8	October 24-28	<i>2 Timothy 3:16</i> "All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work."
9	Oct 31 – Nov 4	<i>Romans 12:2</i> "Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will."
10	November 7-10	<i>Psalms 111:10</i> "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom; all who follow his precepts have good understanding. To him belongs eternal praise."

11	November 14-18	<i>Galatians 5:22-23</i> "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law."
12	November 21-22	<i>Psalms 119:105</i> "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path."
13	November 28-December 2	<i>John 14:6</i> "Jesus answered, 'I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.'"
14	December 5-9	<i>John 3:16</i> "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life."
15	December 12-16	<i>Luke 2:11</i> "Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is Christ the Lord."
16	January 3-6, 2012	<i>Philippians 4:19</i> "And my God will meet all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus."
17	January 9-13	<i>Numbers 23:19</i> " 'God is not a man, that he should lie, nor a son of man, that he should change his mind. Does he speak and then not act? Does he promise and not fulfill?'"
18	January 17-20	<i>1 Corinthians 3:16</i> "Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit lives in you?"
19	January 23-27	<i>Psalms 139:13-14</i> "For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well."
20	January 30 - February 3	<i>Colossians 3:13</i> "Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you."
21	February 6-10	<i>1 Corinthians 13:4-8</i> "Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails."
22	February 13-17	<i>1 Thessalonians 5:16-18</i> "Be joyful always; pray continually; give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus."
23	February 21-24	<i>Psalms 51:10</i> "Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me."

24	February 27 - March 2	<i>Philippians 4:8</i> “Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.”
25	March 5-9	<i>Isaiah 53:1-3</i> “Who has believed our message and to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed? He grew up before him like a tender shoot, and like a root out of dry ground. He had no beauty or majesty to attract us to him, nothing in his appearance that we should desire him. He was despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows, and familiar with suffering. Like one from whom men hide their faces he was despised, and we esteemed him not.”
26	March 12-16	<i>Isaiah 53:4-6</i> “Surely he took up our infirmities and carried our sorrows, yet we considered him stricken by God, smitten by him, and afflicted. But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed. We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all.”
27	March 19-23	<i>Isaiah 53:7-9</i> “He was oppressed and afflicted, yet he did not open his mouth; he was led like a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is silent, so he did not open his mouth. By oppression and judgment he was taken away. And who can speak of his descendants? For he was cut off from the land of the living; for the transgression of my people he was stricken. He was assigned a grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death, though he had done no violence, nor was any deceit in his mouth.”
28	March 26 - 30	<i>Isaiah 53:10-12</i> “Yet it was the Lord’s will to crush him and cause him to suffer, and though the Lord makes his life a guilt offering, he will see his offspring and prolong his days, and the will of the Lord will prosper in his hand. After the suffering of his soul, he will see the light of life and be satisfied; by his knowledge my righteous servant will justify many, and he will bear their iniquities. Therefore I will give him a portion among the great, and he will divide the spoils with the strong, because he poured out his life unto death, and was numbered with the transgressors. For he bore the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.”
29	April 10-13	<i>Proverbs 3:5-6</i> “Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight.”
30	April 16-20	<i>Acts 1:8</i> “But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”
31	April 23-27	<i>Philippians 4:13</i> “I can do everything through Christ who gives me strength.”

32	April 30 - May 4	<i>Ephesians 4:29</i> "Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen."
33	May 7-11	<i>2 Corinthians 5:17</i> "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!"
34	May 14-18	<i>Psalms 121:1-2</i> "I lift up my eyes to the hills—where does my help come from? My help comes from the Lord, the maker of heaven and earth."
35	May 21-25	<i>Isaiah 40:31</i> "But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint."
36	May 29 - June 1	<i>Nahum 1:7</i> "The Lord is good, a refuge in times of trouble. He cares for those who trust in him."
