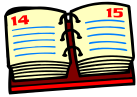

Mock Trial

On Tuesday, April 9, the 7th & 8th grade students conducted a Mock Trial in the courtroom of Judge Charles Tinlin. For the last three months, as part of their Logic/Writing class they have analyzed the High School case posted by the Florida Law Related Education Association. They then form teams (Prosecution and Defense) and assume the roles of attorneys and witnesses in order to try the case in Open Court. The winning team is chosen by a panel of three attorneys who score them according to the High School Rubric.
